Item Purpose

The following changes were made to the policy presented to the Investment Committee as a first reading on March 6, 2024, and highlighted in the attached Collaborative Strategies Portfolio Policy (Redline).

- Clarified the delegation of authority language under the risk management section.

Recommendation

In accordance with the CalSTRS <u>Investment Policy Statement (IPS)</u>, staff is recommending the Investment Committee establish a Collaborative Strategies policy and portfolio as a replacement to the existing <u>Innovative Strategies policy</u> and portfolio. Meketa Investment Group, the Board's consultant, supports the policy language recommended as shown in Attachment 1. If this new policy is approved by the Investment Committee, the Innovative Strategies policy will be decommissioned (Attachment 4), and the appropriate investment policies will be updated administratively to reflect the impacts of the Collaborative Strategies Portfolio Policy.
