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What is Direct Reporting

- Direct Reporting is when a District reports data and contributions to CalSTRS directly no longer submitting data to the County Office of Education (COE).

Criteria to be a Direct Reporting Employer

- District must be fiscally independent or accountable.
- District is in full compliance to submit encrypted files to CalSTRS.
- District historically and currently reports timely data and contributions to CalSTRS.
- District must have a CalSTRS audit within the previous three years demonstrating full compliance with Teachers' Retirement Law

Timeline of Direct Reporting Regulations

- **April 1-3:** Proposed text to Teachers' Retirement Board.
- **Late April:** Publication by Office of Administrative Law in the California Regulatory Notice Register.
- **Early June:** End of 45-day comment period.
- **Early September:** Teachers' Retirement Board to adopt regulations
- **January 1, 2016:** Effective date of regulations
