Changes to Secure Employer Website - Effective December 5, 2014

The New Reduced Workload Program (RWP) Secure Employer Website Edit MO-B120 will ensure assignment codes for RWP (34 and 36) are used when member lines are reported with zero contributions. If you receive MO-B120 edit, please review your records and make sure you have used the correct assignment code.

MO-B120

Contribution Code 2 not permitted for non RWP assignments to be reported on or after the 2014/2015 fiscal year regardless of the service periods. The Member Assignment Code is not reported as 34 or 36

Change in Variance Tolerance on MO-B078 and MO-B079 edits from \$1.00 to \$.01. If you receive MO-B078 and/or MO-B079 edit, please review your contribution calculations.

MO-B078 and MO-B079

Variance edit that alerts employers the reported contribution amounts do not match the calculations.

The Member Contribution Amount reported on the Contribution Line is excessive by more than a cent (\$0.01) for lines reported on or after 07/01/2014.

The Member Contribution Amount reported on the Contribution Line is excessive by more than a dollar (\$1.00) for lines reported prior to 07/01/2014.

Training Tip

SB1220 was signed into law September 28th and will be effective January 1, 2015.

Section 22115 (e) addresses reporting outgrowth activities with a compensation earnable. It states for outgrowth activities the "compensation earnable for those activities shall be determined as if the creditable compensation had been earned at the lowest pay rate for other creditable service activities performed by the member for the same employer during the same school year."

All creditable service performed should be reported with a compensation earnable. This will ensure that members receive service credit when creditable service is performed.
