Dear Senator Leno:

Pursuant to section 22955.5(b) of the California Education Code, the California State Teachers' Retirement System (CalSTRS) shall submit a report each year which includes the amount of teachers' creditable compensation for the fiscal year that ended on the immediately preceding June 30. As required, the report is also being submitted to the Chair of the Joint Legislative Budget Committee and the Legislative Analyst.

The creditable compensation reported to CalSTRS in the fiscal year ended June 30, 2016¹, is \$30,646,894,294.91. CalSTRS will notify your office of any revision on the amount stated above on or before April 15, 2017.

Of the amount of creditable compensation earned and reported for FY2015/2016, \$2,360,325,038.59 is from community colleges.
